Condescending, Racist Elitists

So some schools decided to close their programs for advanced students, because too high a percentage of them were white. This is so annoying, and idiotically racist, but in *both* directions.

That made-up claim soon became a self-fulfilling prophesy: the ones *expected* to be failures ... failed. Because the teachers thought they were going to.

If someone is disadvantaged by being poor, uneducated, etc., yes, it might be extra hard for them to succeed. But to reinforce the idea that "blackness" is, in and of itself, a reason to be a stupid failure, is the most racist bullshit there is. And it is primarily the *left* pushing that shit-though they try to phrase it in such a way that they sound caring and compassionate, when really they're just condescending, racist elitists.
