Snowflaking to Shut Down Arguments

I have seen a lot of posts comparing leftist "snowflakes" to people who get offended on the right, or libertarians. These can make for some cute memes, but there is a qualitative difference.

The left is trying to use hurt feelings as the root of the problem and as a means to control others. This isn't comparable to libertarians or even conservatives. Libertarians and conservatives get offended all of the time, but I have never seen that they use their hurt feelings as the basis of argument that you ought not do something. I am sure there are cases where this has happened, but it isn't really a common thing.
